Sugar-Free Lemon Pound Cake

- | | |
|--|------------------------------|
| 1/3 cup of baking Splenda (granulated) or other artificial sweetener | 3/4 teaspoon baking powder |
| 2 eggs | 1/8 teaspoon salt |
| 3 tablespoons vegetable oil | 1/3 cup confectioners' sugar |
| 3 tablespoons orange juice | 2 tablespoons lemon juice |
| 1/2 teaspoon lemon extract | 2 tablespoons lemon zest |
| 2/3 cup all-purpose flour or cake flour | |

Pre-heat oven to 350°. In a small bowl, combine artificial sugar, egg, vegetable oil, orange juice and lemon extract. In a separate bowl, combine the flour, baking powder and salt; then add to egg mixture and mix well. Pour into a greased and floured 5-3/4-in. x 3-in. x 2-in. loaf pan. Bake for 30-35 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack to cool completely.

For glaze, in a small bowl, whisk confectioners' sugar and lemon juice until smooth; drizzle over cake.

Makes: 1 mini loaf (6 slices). Nutritional Facts 1 slice equals 200 calories.

Schools Out Celebration & Bike Rodeo June 7th at Conway Homes & June 11th at Sierra Vista Homes

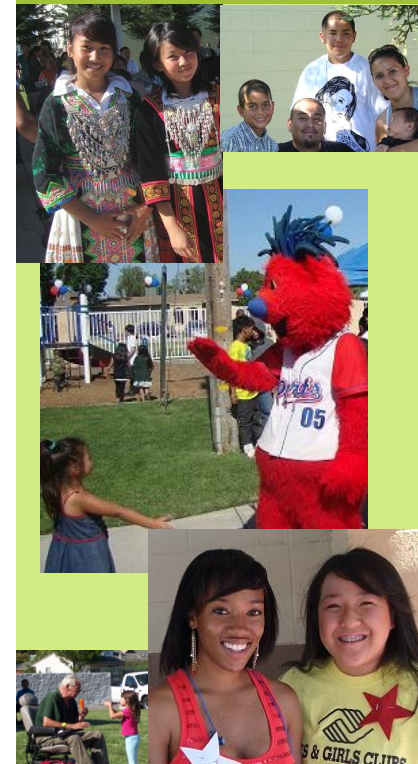
