## Training, Education and Community Room Open at Mokelumne Manor, Thornton, California

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for a Capital Fund Education and Training Community Facilities (CFCF) Competitive Grant. The purpose of the CFCF grant was to provide funding for public housing authorities to develop facilities to provide education, and job training programs.

The Housing Authority prepared a CFCF grant application for the development of a Thornton Education and Job Training Community Center. The Housing Authority sought grant funding to moderately rehabilitate the existing management office/computer lab building located at 26188 N. Manor Drive and to construct a new workshop classroom adjacent behind the existing building located at the same address.

The Housing Authority was successful in its grant application and was awarded nearly \$300,000 in grant funding. Construction was completed in the winter of 2013. It will be available for all residents in Mokelumne Manor, as well as the residents of the surrounding community, including Sartini Manor. It will be a meeting place for Housing Authority-sponsored programs and for the Mokelumne Manor Resident Council.

A Grand Opening is scheduled for June 5, 2014 at 12:30 p.m., which will coincide with the Mokelumne Manor Resident Fair. Everyone is invited to the Grand Opening and is encouraged to participate in the events and programs that will continue to occur at this much needed north-county facility.

On Election Day, June 3, 2014, polls, **including one right in Sierra Vista**, will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Enjoy!

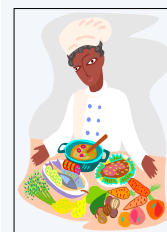


- 2 lbs hamburger
- 2 cans Cream of Mushroom soup (condensed)
- 1 can (empty can from soup) of milk
- 2 tubes of ready-to-bake biscuits

Brown hamburger in a frying pan. Drain off the grease. In the pan, mix together the browned hamburger, soup and milk and heat thoroughly. Pour mixture into a 13 x 9 inch baking pan and top with a layer of biscuits. Bake at the temperature and for as long as recommended on label for biscuits. Remove from oven when biscuits are golden brown.
