



Light Fixtures



The Housing Authority is replacing light fixtures to allow the use of a standard light bulb. The new light fixtures may allow a resident to replace the light with a standard 60 watt light bulb. These light bulbs are sold at locations such as the Dollar Tree, Dollar General, WalMart, Rancho San Miguel, and other stores. Prices may vary.

The Authority is available to replace standard light bulbs in the unit. The residents may contact the Public Housing Office and request a work order for the repair. A fee will be charged to the resident for the light bulb and will appear on the monthly rental statement.

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Mandatory Water Restrictions

Due to mandatory California water restrictions, water usage needs to be decreased by at least 25% or more. Strict water restrictions are enforced and may cause an excess water charge for excessive water use.

Please note: Residents **NOT** following the restrictions will be liable for excess water charges.

Water restriction notices were posted in June. Please contact the Public Housing Office if you need an additional copy.

Please contact the Public Housing Office immediately for leaking faucets or any other water leaks.

Resident Recipe Tex-Mex Deviled Eggs

- 6 eggs
 - 1 tablespoon of finely chopped green onions
 - 1 tablespoon of chopped fresh parsley or cilantro
 - 1 small serrano or jalapeno pepper (seeded and finely chopped)
 - 1/4 cup of mayonnaise
 - 1 teaspoon of mustard
 - 1/4 cup of shredded cheddar cheese
 - 1 teaspoon of chili powder
1. Place eggs in a large saucepan. Cover them with cool water by 1 inch. Slowly bring water to a boil over medium heat. When the water has reached a boil, cover and remove from heat. Let sit 12 minutes or until hard-boiled.
 2. Transfer hard-boiled eggs to a bowl. Place the hard-boiled eggs under cold water. Then peel off the egg shell and cut the egg in half.
 3. Remove the yolks and place them into a small bowl; then mash.
 4. Add the onions, parsley, pepper, mayo, mustard to the mashed yolks.
 5. Take a tablespoon of the mashed yolk mixture and fill the hard-boiled egg.
 6. Top the eggs with a sprinkle of cheddar cheese and chili powder.
 7. Cover and refrigerate for at least an hour.
 8. Serve and enjoy!
