

Subject: Disposition of Surplus Vehicles.

Background Information:

The Housing Authority has three surplus vehicles which should be disposed of as they have outlived their useful life for the Authority. No other operations within the Housing Authority are in need of these obsolete vehicles. The vehicles listed below are recommended for disposal:

| Location | Vehicle | Mileage |
|-----------------|---|----------------|
| Sierra Vista | 1996 Ford Econoline Van (License E033451) | 167,713 |
| Grand Canal | 2001 Dodge Dakota (License 1067977) | 109,641 |
| Grand Canal | 2004 Dodge Stratus (License 1134658) | 63,841 |

Vehicles will be sold through govdeals.com (an online bidding site) which the Authority has used in the past to auction previously approved vehicles for disposition. The online bidding site assists in listing the vehicle on its proprietary website used by public agencies to sell surplus items. Listings are accessible to a very large bidder base worldwide. Once the auction closes and the Housing Authority's minimum bid requirement is met (usually within 7-14 days), the winning bidder will pay for the vehicle electronically via the website and the site will forward the proceeds to the Housing Authority. The winning bidders will pay the website a standard fee which is disclosed on the website prior to bidding.

Recommended Action:

Staff recommends that the Board of Commissioners approve the disposal of the three surplus vehicles listed above.
